- 1. This meeting is held subject to Rules 4, 18, 19A, 19C, 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 78, 86, 88, 91, 96, 146 (i), 148 (i), (ii), (iii), (iii), (iv), (v) paras (a), (b), (c), (g), (h), 264, 267, and Rules 272 to 280, 296, 297, R8 Regulation relating to Passports and the Identification of Horses, R14 Regulation relating to the Taking of Samples from Horses, and Appendix B (Regulations for Point to Point Steeplechases) of the Rules of Racing and the Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Rules.
- Entries received for these races can only be made and accepted on the condition that the Owner,
  Handler and the rider of the horse shall subject themselves in all respects to the Rules and Regulations
  for Point to Point Steeplechases laid down and the decisions made by the Stewards of the Irish
  National Hunt Steeplechase Committee and the Stewards of the Meeting.
- No horse shall be entered or start for any race at this meeting unless a Hunter's Certificate has been
  registered at the Office of the Irish National Hunt Steeplechase Committee and published on its
  website.
- 4. No horse that has won a race under any recognised Rules of Racing or Steeplechase Rules in any country (Hunters Steeplechases, Point to Point Steeplechases and Private Sweepstakes excluded) on or after 1st March prior to the start of the current Point to Point season, shall be eligible to be entered or run in a Point to Point Steeplechase.
- 5. No horse shall be eligible to be entered or run in a Maiden Point to Point Steeplechase if it has won a race under any recognised Rules of Racing or Steeplechase Rules in any country.
- 6. An allowance of 5lbs for riders who have not ridden more than twenty winners combined on the Racecourse or in Point to Points and the allowance will take into account details of wins in Point to Points since 1st September, 2005, and all wins on the racecourse. A list of riders entitled to claim the allowance will be available from the Officials and the Clerk of the Scales at each Point to Point.
- The course will be marked out two or three days before the meeting, when competitors may walk the course, but no riding over it will be allowed or horse and rider will be disqualified.
- 8. The Entry Fee for each horse for each race must be paid with the entry.
- 9. Riders to leave all red flags on the right, white flags on the left.
- 10. All races to be ridden in colours to be declared at entry. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that riders wear the colours printed on the race card, failure to do so will result in the handler being fined
- All runners and riders must be declared to the Clerk of the Scales at least one hour before the advertised start time of each race.
- 12. Permits to ride must be available at the Scales
- 13. No person other than a Qualified Rider under I.N.H.S. Rules or those specified in Regulation 23 (b) (ii) (b) shall ride in a Point to Point race.
- 14. Every Owner shall pay a levy of €10 per race to the Qualified Riders Accident Fund. This amount is included in the Entry Fee.
- 15. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that the horse carries the correct weight.
- 16. No responsibility taken for loss or accident of any kind.
