Registration process for Irish Point-to-Points

Each week, a link will be provided for weekend registration. www.ihrb.ie

Registration is only open to essential staff:

- Handlers (who have entries at the relevant meetings)
- Riders (with engagements at the relevant meetings)
- Hunt Volunteers (required to run the relevant meetings)
- Medical Staff/Veterinary Staff
- Commentator/Reporter/Video Provider
- Stable Staff
- IHRB Staff

Step 1

Click on 'Register'

From the dropdown select '1' on the day ticket relevant to you. In the instance that you will be attending both days, select '1' in the dropdown for both day tickets. (you can only select '1' per day)

Click Register (Register button will appear in orange once tickets are selected) on the bottom of the page to proceed to the next stage.

If you think you might be required to attend more than one fixture at a weekend ensure to select a ticket for Saturday and Sunday as you will not be able gain entry without a QR code for each day.

Step 2

Fill in the information required.

Contact Information – First Name, Surname, Email, Confirm Email (ensure correct email address is provided as this is where tickets will be sent to), mobile phone.

Home Address – Address 1, Address 2, City, County, Country

What is your role at the fixture? (tick role that applies to you)

If *Hunt Volunteer* is selected – it will then ask what is your role at the event? Please type in answer eg. Fence steward

If *Stable Staff* is selected – it will then ask what handler do you work for? Please type in answer eg. Joe Bloggs

What fixture(s) do think you will be attending? (Select the fixture(s) you will be attending.)

Ensure to answer all the questions by ticking on the Yes or No boxes.

When all questions are answered, click on register (register button will turn orange once all questions are answered).

Order confirmation screen will then appear, it will show email address of where the tickets were sent.

Check your email after registration to ensure you received your tickets, the tickets containing your QR code will be in a pdf attachment in email.

You will need to present this QR code at the gate where it will be scanned in order to gain admission to the venue. If you do not receive a QR code please phone 045-885622 as you will not be able to gain access to the fixture without it.

If you have answered 'Yes' to any of the questions during the Medical Screening, you will receive a call from the IHRB Senior Medical Officer or relevant person and until you have received the goahead from them, your QR code will not be valid.

If it is not deemed safe for you to attend, you will be informed of this and your QR access will be made void, preventing you from getting access at the gate.

How to present QR Code:

The QR code sent in email can be printed if the attendee doesn't have a smartphone.


If the attendee has a smartphone, the QR code can be accessed on their smartphone via their email or they can screenshot the QR code and can be then accessed from their photos.

If you have requested a ticket for Saturday and Sunday, the QR code for the second day will appear in page 2 of the PDF.

When entering the fixture please present the QR Code for scanning.
